

A Message from Our Leadership

Dear Supporters and Friends,

Our 2022 fiscal year (July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022) was, as with the previous year, significantly affected by the pandemic. During the first half of the year, we had to operate under strict safety protocols as required by our local health department and CDC guidelines. Measures included: continued mask-wearing during indoor activities; social distancing; frequent handwashing; disinfection of program areas; and more. We also had to limit the number of youth we were able to serve, which was especially difficult, as many more families were looking to enroll their children.

Late in the fall of 2021, based on CDC guidance and following the Lawrence Public Schools' protocols, we were finally able to relax some of the safety procedures and return to more normal operations. Doing so significantly boosted our daily attendance, which quickly grew from the previous average of 200 youth attending daily to approximately 350. We met this increasing membership with some setbacks. During the holiday season, many of our members – as well as our staff – contracted the virus, which hampered the Club's progress in returning to normal. Late winter into early spring, we finally reached a positive turning point, and the pandemic's impact became less noticeable.

Throughout the year, we continued to run a wide range of enrichment programs in our three main focus areas: academic success; healthy lifestyles; and character and leadership development. We met our members' day-to-day needs as well by providing daily dinner, and during the summer program, breakfast and lunch. In spite of the year's challenges, we are proud of our ability to maneuver through these obstacles with creativity, resiliency, and adaptability. We never lost sight of our youths' essential needs. The Club couldn't have done it without its dedicated staff and Board of Directors, and we are forever thankful for their hard work and commitment during this difficult time.

We are also indebted to all of our supporters. Without your help, we would have not been able to make it through this difficult year. Many of you saw and understood the challenges and stepped in to provide additional help. The Club was also able to tap into funds tied to federal and state recovery initiatives. All of these supports helped us weather the storm. This last year proved that the sum is stronger than the parts: together we can persevere even under the most difficult circumstances. With your continued support, we are confident that our Club will remain the guiding light for thousands of Lawrence youths.

Our Commitment: Paving a Better Path for Youth

The Boys & Girls Club of Lawrence has a 130-year history of delivering a range of innovative programs and activities for some of the poorest children in the Commonwealth. The club continually refines and enhances offerings that inspire youth members to pursue academic success, make healthy choices, and become leaders of integrity and character.

Academic Success

In the previous year, our members faced hardships as they transitioned into a remote learning environment. This year, our Education Center Staff focused heavily on educational programming and getting our member's grades back on track. Our youth were immersed into new reading programs, STEM activities, and Think Ahead Thursdays. Another significant focus was getting our male basketball team members motivated and interested in either college or trade school. Through discussions and lectures with professionals, the effects of this program are proving to be successful. Our goal is to help Club kids become the best versions of themselves.





Healthy Lifestyles

At the beginning of the year, the Club followed Covid-19 guidelines of social distancing and mask-wearing. However, as time progressed, our members were allowed more freedom to engage and participate in healthy and safe activities. The kids participated in dance, sports teams, and swimming throughout the year. During the summer, they played in the gym, got some cardio in the gamesroom, and tackle new adventures with the running club. On top of the physical activities, they enjoyed healthy and balanced snacks and meals.

Character and Leadership

The Club prides itself on character, leadership, and overall growth. Staff vow to be great mentors to our youth by being attentive and aiding them in any way. This year, our Youth of the Year, Faith Omosefe, is an excellent example of how our staff is impacting their lives. Faith has won every competition thus far and will compete in the National Tournament this October. Our staff also tackled topics plaguing today's youth, such as drugs and alcohol, sex education, life after high school, and money management.

(1) Our BGCL Dance Academy and Director of Dance, Kathy C., put together a showcase highlighting Hispanic Heritage that included speakers, dance, songs, and amazing costumes!

(2) Our volunteer coordinator, Suzanne F., brought in a therapy dog named Mikey for our members! The kids love Mikey and enjoy cuddling, reading, and spending time with him.

(3) Our Education Director, Karen K., along with volunteer Patty B., put together this fantastic program that teaches our members about financial responsibility, entrepreneurship, and teamwork.

(4)The kids were introduced to Oobleck. Along with some volunteers from the Brooks School, our members learned how to create this substance and the scientific facts behind it.

(5) On International Girl Day, our Girl Lab friends celebrated Girls Day for the first time since the pandemic and the girls had a blast! They learned how to create a rocket lander using marshmallows.

(6) This Black History Month, our Arts & Crafts Instructor, Sandy T., blended art and history. Covering prominent black historical figures, she and the kids painted murals, canvases, and learned facts about each person.















(7) Faith Omosefe was awarded as the Club's Youth of The Year and has since gone on to compete and win the state and regional titles. She will be competing for the National title in October.

(8) Construction workers who helped build the current Club building did a program where they taught the kids about land surveying and brought them outside for some hands on experience.

(9) Our members were challenged to see who could read 25 books in a month alongside a few volunteers from The Brooks School.

(10) Along with kids from other local Clubs, our members enjoyed a STEM activity filled day at the local Thermo Fischer office! They learned how to use light and lasers.

(11) Two teachers from the Lawrence Technical School hosted a barbering and cosmetology trades program for our middle school aged members.

(12) Greater Lawrence Technical School came to the Club and presented on video game creation. They also assisted our members in creating their own video games.

(13) This summer was a hot one and our kids stayed cool with fun and memorable trips to the beach.


