EXPLORING MEDICINE AT MGH

Eighteen BGCL members between grades 7 and 12 attended the MGH Learning Lab Fieldtrip on Wednesday, April 23, during Spring break, marking their second year at Mass General Hospital. They engaged hands-on with medical professionals, including a nurse, radiologist, and a surgeon in residency. Split into two groups, the students worked with robotic patient dummies, learning to assess vitals and handle medical emergencies, such as an allergic reaction requiring an epinephrine injection. Dr. Oz appeared via a screen to answer questions, adding to the excitement. Medical personnel also shared their career journeys and educational



paths, providing insights into various medical fields. Additionally, they presented on allergic reactions versus allergies and the use of epinephrine. This experience aims to spark interest in the medical profession and equip students with valuable knowledge about healthcare.




Swing for a Cause on June 16!
